
WHAT EXACTLY IS A MEMBER RANCH?



SEASON

In Colorado, the world changes along with the current season. Each one offers its own unique palette of vibrant colors and favored activities fit for the conditions. And the best part? There's no bad time to visit! Many of our ranches offer year-round availability. Summer months tend to be more sought-out after, while the winter months see fewer crowds and more tranquility. Regardless of your choice, you'll find a myriad of things to add to your itinerary.

AUTUMN

Autumn may very well be Colorado's most underappreciated season. It's the best time to see the state's truest colors, made possible by vibrant aspen groves and speckled trees lining the foothills and mountainside of the Rockies. It's stunningly beautiful and complemented further by crisp air—an appreciated break after the summer's heat has passed. Many ranches offer discounted rates for this season as well.



In the wintertime, you're likely to find your ranch covered in a blanket of white. Quiet, relaxing, and the least busy of all four seasons, winter marks a fantastic time to visit if you're looking for a slower pace with less hustle and bustle. The snowy months (typically December - April depending on location and elevation) offer a handful of new activities. Sledding, snowmobiling, skiing, and snowshoeing are all on the docket for those interested in playing in the snow.

SPRING

When the mountains begin to thaw come spring, Colorado waterways get replenished offering stunning wildflowers and green meadows. With cool temperatures and snow-covered peaks to be found from any given vista, it's an inspiring time to be in the mountains and the perfect chance for a corporate getaway.

SUMMER

Colorado summers are hard to beat—warm temperatures, fresh air, and long nights under the stars are what our cowboy dreams are made of. With longer days, you can fit in twice as many activities and adventures compared to the winter months. Is your itinerary ready?









ACTIVITY

HORSEBACK RIDING

Cantering a horse through an alpine meadow or climbing a steep trail through a pine forest is something you never forget. Being in the saddle of a Colorado dude ranch well-trained horse is the fastest way to connect to a truly western experience. Whether you are a new rider or experienced, it's also a whole lot of fun. Trail riding, cattle roundups, team penning, overnight pack trips, gymkhanas and family rodeos are a few of the ways you can get to know your mount.

HIKING

There are many ways to explore the wilderness and hiking happens to be one of Colorado's most popular pastimes. Many ranches offer guided historic tours, nature walks and hikes to summit some of the Colorado's tallest peaks.

SKIING

Light snow and great ski resorts are ubiquitous in Colorado. Many ranches offer access to epic backcountry and cross country trails, and world class ski resorts.

FISHING / FLY FISHING

Many of our dude ranches can outfit you with the latest gear or put you in touch with a seasoned outfitter for instruction and guided trips.

SWIMMING

Looking up at the summer sky while floating in cool water or lounging poolside is a great way to relax after a long ride or hike. Some ranches offer ponds and streams with swimming beaches and decks.

O CAMPFIRES AND COOKOUTS

Campfires bring people together for conversation, stories, songs and the occasional marshmallow. Camp cooks love to create over an open flame. From Dutch oven soufflés and cakes to stews and steaks, campfire cooking is mighty tasty.

RIVER RAFTING

Float a class-one river with a fly rod or paddle through class-five whitewater. Most dude ranches offer a time in the week for rafting. Our dude ranches contract with the best, most reputable outfitters around.

KAYAKING

Not offered as part of a standard package but this sport is growing in popularity. Ask before you book to see if kayaking is an activity that can be arranged.
